Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari/Mandamus for quashing the impugned transfer order dated 30.07.2021 (P-1) passed by respondent No.1, on the ground that petitioner is a person with permanent disability to the extent of 52%.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 03.08.2021 (P-3) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, A.A.G.,

Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf

of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the consensus arrived at between both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 03.08.2021 (P-3), in accordance with law by passing speaking order expeditiously, but not later than 12.08.2021.
