Case taken up through video conferencing.

The grouse of the petitioner Karan Gera is that he has been working as Computer Operator in the office of Municipal Committee, Ratia on contractual basis on DC rate, however, he has not been paid salary since November, 2020 and rather, respondent no.4 is in the process of changing the nomenclature of petitioner also.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner had submitted written representations, copies Annexures P-10 and P-11 to respondent No.5 but without evoking any response.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and Mr. B.R. Mahajan, Advocate General, Haryana with Ms. Shubra Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner

would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to dispose of representations of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents state that such respondents would comply with any such direction issued by this Court.

Heard.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No.5-Secretary, Municipal Committee, Ratia, District Fatehabad to look into representations submitted by the petitioner, copies Annexures P-10 and P-11 and if some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law, within a period of 06 weeks from today.

It is observed that if salary has not been paid to the petitioner since November 2020 and there is no legal impediment in release of the same to the petitioner, then the necessary payment be made to the petitioner at the earliest. It is further observed that in case the petitioner feels dissatisfied after disposal of his written representations, then he may approach the Court again in accordance with law for redressal of his grievances.
