The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in NCB Crime No.65 dated 10.10.2017, registered under Sections 8, 20, 29, 60 and 61 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Kathu Nangal, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Admittedly, the prosecution has already led its entire prosecution and the petitioner's trial is now fixed before the Trial Court for leading of defence evidence. Therefore, at the fag end of the petitioner's trial, it is not considered desirable to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

Since the petitioner is in custody from 10.10.2017, the Trial Court is directed to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial within two months from the date next fixed before it, in accordance with law.
