In this petition, two primary prayers have been made. First prayer is for directing the respondents to file the Status Report of investigation/enquiry into the complaints made to respondent Nos.4 and 2.

Faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in case titled **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, reported as 2008(2) SCC 409** and in **M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, Criminal Appeal No.102 of 2011, decided on 20.03.2020**, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition qua first prayer with liberty to seek alternative remedies in accordance with law.

Second prayer in the present petition is for directing respondent

No.4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

The petitioner is a company.

During the course of arguments, it has been pointed out that in fact, the said direction is sought for one Shankar Lal Aggarwal who is stated to be a senior citizen. However, since the said Shankar Lal Aggarwal is not the petitioner before this Court, thus, no effective order in favour of the said Shankar Lal Aggarwal can be passed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition even qua second prayer also with liberty to file appropriate petition on behalf of Shankar Lal Aggarwal on the aspect of protection of life and liberty.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberties.

The withdrawal of the present petition would not come in the way of Sh. Shankar Lal Aggarwal to file petition for protection of life and liberty which would be considered on its own merits.
