By way of filing the present writ petition, petitioner Vijay Kumar, who was initially appointed on contract basis with the respondents and working as such till now, when it came to issuance of an experience certificate to the petitioner, he found that on account of his experience, he had been awarded 2 marks out of 5 marks, resultantly, his name did not figure properly in the tentative seniority list of Lab Technician, seeks issuance of direction to the respondents to award the correct marks of experience. Though, the petitioner had represented to the official respondents to correct the tentative seniority list but to no effect.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4.

At asking of the Court, Ms. Shubhra Singh, Addl. AG, Haryana and Mr. Teevar Sharma, accept notice on behalf of such respondents.

In order to avoid unnecessary litigation and to afford official

respondents an opportunity to consider the claim of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of directing respondents No.1 to 4 to consider the representation of the petitioner in accordance with law, rules and instructions on the subject and if some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done, within a period of two months from today.

For the purpose of consideration, the present writ petition along with annexures be treated as a representation on behalf of the petitioner.
