By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of General Diary no.5 dated 9.9.2020, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 324/323/148/149 of the IPC (with Section 326 of the IPC having been added later on), (recorded as a cross-case in FIR no.140 dated 8.9.2019, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 324/452/148/149 of the IPC).

Orders having been passed by this court on 05.10.2020 and 07.12.2020 directing all parties concerned to appear before the learned Area Magistrate/trial court up-to 22.12.2020 to record their statements in respect of any compromise reached between them, the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, dated 08.01.2021, is on record stating to the effect that none of the parties appeared before that court to make any statement up-till 22.12.2020.

Thereafter, on 16.02.2021, the turn of the case having come up after 04:00 p.m., none was present for the petitioners and consequently, the

matter had been adjourned till today, to be shown in the urgent motion list to enable counsel for the petitioners to come present to raise any contention that he wishes to.

Today, even on 3rd call, none is present.

It being a petition filed under the provisions of Section 482 of the Cr.P.C., dismissed for want of prosecution.
