At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks the permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that the petitioner would be moving a fresh representation to respondent No.2, exclusively praying therein for the protection of her own as well as her husband's lives and liberty and he also prays that the said respondent be directed to take appropriate action on the said representation of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Ms. Samina Dhir, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in this case in pursuance of the copies of this petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, has no objection to the above-said submission as well as prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand is hereby dismissed for having been withdrawn, with the observations that in case, the petitioner moves a fresh representation to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, restricting her prayer therein to the protection of her own as well as her husband's lives and liberty only, then the said respondent shall look into the same and in case the petitioner and her husband would be found to be genuinely deserving the protection of their lives and liberty, then he shall take appropriate action in accordance with law, in the given set of facts and circumstances of the matter, preferably within a period of ten days thereafter.
