The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the gratuity and leave encashment of the petitioner along with interest @ 18% p.a. from the date of his retirement i.e. 31.12.2012 and to decide the representation dated 20.09.2013 (Annexure P-4).

Records perused.

On perusal of the records as none has put in appearance from either side, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 20.09.2013 (Annexure P4) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
