Case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 154 dated 21.07.2021, registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station City – 1 Abohar, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 10.08.2021, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 10.08.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bahadur

Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 10.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
