Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned action of the respondents while not granting benefits to petitioners which were allowed to their co-employees appointed in the year 2016 under B.C. category.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 08.06.2021 (P-11) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to

respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-11) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of four months from today.

Petitioners would be at liberty to make supplementary representation to the legal notice (P-11), if so advised.
