The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to the official respondents to register the FIR under Section 406, 498-A, 494, 354, 354-D, 312, 313, 376, 511 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite representations/complaints dated 10.12.2020 and 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-3 and P-4 respectively) having been made to the authorities concerned, no action has been taken by the official respondents. He submits that petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondents No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the complaint dated representations/complaints dated 10.12.2020 and 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-3 and P-4 respectively) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate action under the provisions of law.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, Punjab is directed to look into the representations/complaints dated 10.12.2020 and 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-3 and P-4 respectively) made by the petitioner and take appropriate steps/action, if any, required under the provisions of law.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
