The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 118 dated 10.08.2020 under Sections 22, 29 and 25 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

Vide order dated 08.09.2020, this Court while granting the petitioner to concession of interim anticipatory bail and directed to abide by conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 08.09.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
