The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition, the petitioners pray for issuance of a direction to the respondents to pay the benefits under the policy of rehabilitation and re-settlement of land owners-land acquisition oustees dated 15.11.2006.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not being paid the royalty-annuity as per the scheme with respect to their entire land, which was subject matter of acquisition. It has been noticed that the respondent no.3-Executive Engineer, Gaggar Water Services Division, Sirsa, in its reply Annexure P-11 has taken a stand that the petitioners are not entitled to annuity with respect to the land acquired vide award No.11 dated 28.03.2002.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that the acquisition vide award No.11 dated 28.03.2002 was set aside and

thereafter, the land was re-acquired.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Financial Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Government of Haryana, Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, Civil Secretariat, Haryana, Chandigarh, to examine the matter and pass a speaking order within a period of two months, after granting opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
