Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.27 dated 17.05.2019, registered under Sections 120-B, 328, 376(2) (N), 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 201 IPC vide order dated 06.01.2020, at Police Station Women, Sonipat, Haryana.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that vide order dated 05.02.2020, the parties were directed to appear in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court wherein the matter has been finally settled and divorce has also finally taken place.
