This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Learned counsel for applicant-respondent no.4 submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous.

Prayer in this writ petition is for taking action against respondent no.6, as it is contended that he is ineligible to hold the post of Lecturer-cum-Instructor in Institute of Hotel Management (for short 'IHM'), Jyotisar.

Learned counsel for applicant-respondent no.4 submits that order dated 29.01.2021, dismissing respondent no.6 from the post of

Assistant Lecturer-cum-Assistant Instructor in IHM, has been passed. Therefore, this writ petition is rendered infructuous. Learned counsel for the petitioners does not deny the same.

At request and with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, hearing of this writ petition is preponed from 03.12.2021 for today itself.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, CM-12759-CWP of 2021 is allowed and CWP No. 15682 of 2019 is disposed of as infructuous. Needless to say, respondent no.6 is at liberty to avail the remedy/remedies as may be available to him for challenging order dated 29.01.2021.
