The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

On 05.10.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that his client is willing to pay some amount to Rs.5,51,087/-, which is outstanding against his wife and son and his electricity connection may be restored.

Accordingly, this Court is of the opinion that if the petitioner deposits a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- with the respondents, they shall restore the electricity connection of the petitioner. The petitioner shall, thereafter, make efforts to deposit the outstanding by way of installments as held out by counsel for the petitioner.

List on 18.01.2021.

The said deposits will be subject to the final decision of the present case.

Reply by filed by the respondents, in the meantime.”

Sh. Alok Mittal, learned counsel representing the PSPCL has pointed out that the electricity connection of the petitioner has been restored on deposit of Rs.1,50,000/-, however, he has not paid a penny thereafter.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that he has repeatedly been visiting the office of the Electricity Board to deposit the entire amount.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner shall prepare a demand draft of the entire balance amount drawn in favour of the PSPCL within a period of 15 days and forward it to through registered post.

If the PSPCL does not receive the amount through a demand draft within three weeks, from today, the Corporation shall be at liberty to disconnect the electricity connection of the petitioner.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
