This is a petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent- University to issue the admit card of Final semester of petitioners for B.P.Ed regular examination September, 2020 for theory exams and to allow them to appear in the exam as the classmates of the petitioners have already been issued their admit cards on dated 02.09.2020 and the theory exam are scheduled since 04.09.2020 to 09.09.2020.

Learned counsel for the respondent- University has submitted that pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court the petitioners have appeared in the examination in some of the papers. The University shall hold additional exam for these students for the subjects in which they could not appear earlier, by the end of February, 2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has also submitted that the

petitioners have already appeared in examination in some of the subjects. If the University holds additional exams for the remaining subjects as well, and declare their result quickly; they shall be fully satisfied.

In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the University, the present petition is allowed. However, it is directed that the respondent- University shall hold the additional exam for the subjects in which these students could not appear earlier, by the end of the February. After their examination is over, the result of these students shall be declared at the earliest possible. It is also clarified that undisputedly since the students had already paid the examination fees to their institute, therefore, the University shall not charge the examination fee from the students again. However, the right of the University to recover the examination fees for these students from the respondent- Institute shall remain open.
