The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order direction in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also to give prior notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case they are required for any investigation.

It is the case of the petitioners that the son of the petitioners is involved in some cases but however, the petitioners are not involved in any case and if the petitioners are required to be called in any case a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be issued and their life and liberty be protected.

Learned State counsel has stated that on instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh that the petitioners are not involved in any matter and are not required by the police. It has also been submitted that it is the son of the petitioners who is involved in two FIRs.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners are required in the two FIRs in which the petitioners' son is an accused then respondent No.2 would look into the matter.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to move a representation before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran in case of any apprehension in future and in case such a representation is moved then respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Disposed of in the above-said terms.
