The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.150 dated 01.07.2021, under Sections 170, 171, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged in the FIR that one of the petitioners had impersonated as a Drug Inspector and another as his PA. They asked the owner of the medical store for his licence. When the complainant asked for their ID cards, they ran away. He also contends that the petitioners do not have any criminal antecedents.

This Court, by order dated 11.08.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh, states that although the petitioners have joined investigation but they are not cooperating.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 11.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
