Prayer in both these petitions is for grant of regular bail to
petitioners Ramandeep Bangar @ Ramandeep and Davinder Pal @ Kaka, in
FIR No.53 dated 06.04.2020 under Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act and Section

188 IPC, registered at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the police party apprehended two persons, who were riding on a motorcycle, as they tried to run away on seeing the police parties. Driver of the motorcycle disclosed his name as Ramandeep, whereas pillion rider disclosed his name as Davinder Pal @ Kaka. From Ramandeep, 13 bottles of Avil 10 ml each and 13 injections of Rexogesic of 2 ml each containing buprenorphine salt, were recovered, which does not fall under NDPS Act. Similarly, from Davinder Pal @ Kaka, 12 bottles of Avil 10 ml each and 12 injections of Rexogesic of 2 ml each containing buprenorphine salt were recovered. It is further submitted that proper procedure has not been followed by the police.

Learned State counsel has, however, opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that as per FSL report, buprenorphine salt was found in the contraband recovered from the petitioners. It is submitted that challan has been presented; charges are yet to be framed and the petitioners are in custody of only about 10 months, as per the custody certificate.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the allegations in the FIR, I find no ground to grant regular bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, both these petitions are dismissed.
