The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 28.08.2020 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A and 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Purana Shalla, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court vide order dated 09.09.2020, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that the matter inter se the parties has been compromised and the parties are residing together and a baby girl has been born.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant pleads no instructions.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
