This common order shall dispose of above noted three criminal

writ petitions as they are similar in nature.

During the course of arguments, it transpires that the Govt. of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice has written a letter dated 01.05.2019 (Annexure P-6) observing that since the investigation was carried out by the CBI, which is a Central Investigation Agency and consultation is required under Section 435 Cr.P.C., the decision of Central Government may be sent to State Government as early as possible.

Learned senior counsel fairly concedes that neither CBI nor the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India is arrayed as party to these petitions.

In view of the same, learned senior counsel seeks withdrawal of the present petitions with liberty to file afresh with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
