The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 19 dated 07.03.2020 under Sections 452, 324, 325, 326, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise dated 17.08.2020.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 appeared.

Vide order dated 29.10.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 08.12.2020 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 22.12.2020 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Batala, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Batala and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that she is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 19 dated 07.03.2020 under Sections 452, 324, 325, 326, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
