This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking extension of interim bail granted to the petitioner by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide order dated 30.07.2021 in FIR No. 216 dated 21.12.2020 under Sections 306, 34 IPC and 304-B IPC added later on registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana, on account of death of his father, who died on 27.07.2021, for attending his last rites.

Learned counsel would contend that the said interim bail is expiring today, however, he has not been able to complete all the family rituals within the specified time and prays for extension of one day time for immersing the ashes of his father in Holy river of Ganga at Haridwar.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. In order to enable the petitioner to immerse the ashes of his father and complete other related rituals, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order 30.07.2021 is extended till 10.08.2021 against the bonds already furnished before the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana. He will surrender before the jail authorities on 11.08.2021 by 4.00 p.m.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
