The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 321 dated 30.05.2020 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 201 of IPC at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar.

Copy of the compromise dated 02.03.2021 effected between the parties and the affidavit filed by the complainant-Rajnish Bakshi son of Jagmohan Bakshi is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 27.07.2020.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Janak Raj, submits that she is not in the knowledge of such compromise. However, she states that the petitioner is in custody

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Noticing the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 27.07.2020; the matter has been compromised between the parties and the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly.
