Case heard by video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.94, dated 16.04.2019, registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 279/337/338/427 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (copy Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioner and respondent no.2 .

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 04.12.2020, the report of the learned SDJM, Amloh, dated 18.12.2020, is on record, stating to the effect that complainant in the FIR, i.e. respondent no.2 (Dimple), as also the injured i.e. respondents no.3 and 4, Ganesh Mukhian alias Dinesh Mukhian and Santosh, appeared before that court and recorded their respective statements to the effect that a compromise has been effected between the parties, and as per

the assessment of that court, the statements of respondents no.2 to 4 (as also of the petitioner-accused Ram Parkash), were made without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.2, having filed a power of attorney duly executed by respondent no.2 in his favour, does not deny the factum of the compromise even today.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed and the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.94, dated 16.04.2019, registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, Distict Fatehgarh Sahib, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 279/337/338/427 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
