1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 22.04.2021 in CWP No.8666 of 2021.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 22.04.2021, CWP No.8666 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 i.e. Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula to consider the case of the petitioner and to pass a speaking order within 02 months.
4. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the filing of the instant petition, the respondent has passed order dated 05.08.2021, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.08.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, as well as the position noted above and am of the view that on account of passing of order dated 05.08.2021, there is substantial compliance with the orders of the Writ Court dated 22.04.2021 in CWP No.8666 of 2021, therefore, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

6. Accordingly, the contempt petition is *disposed of*, as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.08.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
