Petitioners Baljinder Malik and Dev Singh, working with Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam-respondent No.1 by way of filing the present writ petition crave for issuance of direction to the official respondents to set up their pay at par with their co-employees/juniors, who are drawing more pay than the petitioners.

According to learned counsel for the petitioners, the petitioners had served a legal notice dated 24.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) upon the respondents but without evoking any response.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to dispose of the legal notice in a fixed time frame.

Learned State counsel appearing for the respondents states that respondents would abide by any such direction issued by this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.3 to look into the grievances of the petitioners as contained in legal notice (Annexure P-5) and if he finds that some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law, within a period of two months from today.
