The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of writ especially in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that it is a case where petitioner No.1- girl was married to respondent No.6 but thereafter, respondent No.6 started harassing and maltreating the petitioner on the pretext of demand of dowry and he was also habitual of taking intoxicants and started giving beatings to petitioner No.1. In the Month of

May 2021, she was thrown out of the matrimonial home and when she came to her own home, her parents also refused to keep her and therefore, she has now started living with petitioner No.2. He has submitted that in view of the aforesaid position, the private respondents have started harassing the family members of petitioner No.2 as well and have also threatened to kill them. He has submitted that a representation dated 30.7.2021 (Annexure P-3), was sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur, but no action has been taken on the same.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1, 2 and 3 only.

Mr.Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the aforesaid respondents and states that he has no objection in case the representation of the petitioner is directed to be considered and decided in accordance with law.

In view of above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur, to look into the representations representation dated 30.7.2021 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks after the receipt of a copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case any protection is required for the petitioners, the same shall be ensured in accordance with law.
