This is claimant's appeal seeking modification of award i.e.
passed by MACT, Narnaul.

On request, the instant matter taken in Bi-Monthly Lok Adalat,
accordingly discussed.

Mr. Sanjay Mittal, learned counsel for the appellant has not
joined the group, however, he has given his consent through whatsapp group
which reads as under:-

*“Appellant is ready to receive 40,000/- rupees extra and
above the amount awarded by the court below.”*

As per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned
counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company
(separately recorded), a sum of Rs.40,000/- (Rs. Forty Thousand only) over
and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant
in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement
of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the
appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.40,000/- in the name of the Legal Representatives of deceased-appellant-Yad Ram with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent –Insurance Company. The appellant counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
