The petitioners are seeking a direction from this Court to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life & liberty from respondents Nos.4 to 6 i.e. parents/relatives of the petitioner No.2, as the petitioner No.2 has left her home and is living with petitioner No.1. Learned counsel for the petitioners further argues that both the petitioners are major by age and living together and they want to live their independent life without any interference from the parents/relatives of petitioner No.2 i.e. respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already approached the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Ambala seeking protection to their life and liberty by way of filing a representation dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-4). Prayer of the petitioners is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take appropriate decision on the representation, which the petitioners alleged to have made on 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-4), expressing apprehension about danger to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents Nos.4 to 6 within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. In case any merit is found in the representation, the appropriate action will be taken by respondent No.2 to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
