1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentionally and willfully disobeying order Annexure P-1 dated 02.08.2021 in CWP No.14422-2021.
3. Learned counsel contends that the respondents having allowed the petitioner to join at his current place of posting in terms of order dated 02.08.2021, the petitioner does not wish to press the Contempt petition.
4. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of directions contained in paragraph No. 6 of order dated 02.08.2021 in CWP No.14422 of 2021 having been complied with by allowing the petitioner to join at his current place of posting, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondents.
