Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 17.06.2021 to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to look into and decide representation dated 17.06.2021 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
