The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.75 dated 16.03.2021 registered at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal, under Sections 384, 34 IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from HC Shiv Kumar of the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 12.08.2021 as passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

Keeping in view of the above-discussed submission, as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 12.08.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
