1. Prayer in the petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.95 dated 27.05.2019 registered under Sections 22,61, 85 NDPS Act at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar.

2. Learned counsel states that he does not press the instant petition at this stage and would be satisfied if the same is disposed of by directing the learned trial Court to expedite conduct of the trial.

3. The same is not opposed to by the learned State Counsel.

Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage while directing the learned trial Court to expedite the conduct of trial in accordance with law by taking into account that charges were framed in the year 2019.
