By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail', upon FIR no.120, dated 11.07.2021, having been registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

Pursuant to the order dated 12.08.2021, learned State counsel submits, on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh, that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently at least his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
