The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has apprehension of her life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 7. In this regard, she has given a detailed representation dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) to respondent Nos.2 and 3. That the petitioner would be satisfied at the stage, in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) and after inquiring into the whole aspect, take action in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

On advance notice, Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

After considering facts and circumstances of the present case, this Court deems it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) and after making necessary

inquiries, respondent No.2 shall take appropriate action in accordance with law.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not gone into the merits of the allegations made by the petitioner and it would be open to respondent No.2 to make their independent inquiry/assessment with regard to the representation dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-2).

In view of what has been observed above, the present petition is disposed of in the above-said terms.
