Petitioner Harpreet Kaur, working as Junior Engineer-I in the office of Superintending Engineer, Vigilance, Haryana Power Utilities, Sector-6, Panchkula has filed the present writ petition craving for issuance of direction to the respondents to grant one annual increment for the financial year 2010-2011 to the petitioner by counting extraordinary leaves sanctioned by the respondents for pursuing higher technical studies as is permissible under Note 5 b(ii) below Rule 4.9 (a) of Punjab CSR Vol.I Part-I (applicable to Haryana) and adopted by the Nigam.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner had submitted several representations including legal notice dated 02.06.2021 (Annexure P-13) to the respondents but without evoking any response.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to dispose of the legal notice in a fixed time frame.

Learned State counsel appearing for the respondents states that respondents would abide by any such direction issued by this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.4-Superintending Engineer/Admin.II, Shakti Bhawan, Sector-6, Panchkula to look into the grievances of the petitioner as contained in legal notice (Annexure P-13) and if he finds that some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law, within a period of two months from today.
