The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.74 dated 13.06.2021, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Phase 11, Mohali, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

The operative part of the order dated 13.08.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“....Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a lady aged about 36 years and is having two minor children and younger one is aged about 07 months. It is further submitted that primary allegations are against husband of the petitioner Sheetal Singh, in whose account, an amount of Rs.7.65 lacs and another amount of Rs.75,000/- was deposited by the victim through two cheques. It is also submitted that the petitioner was an employee of Child Abroad Education and not Stewart Placement Service.

Notice of motion for 28.10.2021....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 13.08.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jeet Chand, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.08.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
