The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 175 dated 13.10.2020, under Sections 307, 364, 379-B, 427, 506, 148, 149 and 323 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner is named in the FIR but no injury is attributed to him. He further contends that it is alleged that a shot had been fired by co-accused Rajbir which had hit the complainant on his left hand. The complainant had allegedly been abducted but released after 4 hours. The petitioner is in custody for over 1 year and 1 month. Co-accused Saudagar Singh @ Sagar, Sarwan Singh @ Samma and Harpreet Singh @ Happy have been granted bail by this court in CRM-M-6794-2021 on 18.02.2021, CRM-M-8621-2021 on 02.03.2021 and CRM-M-1734-2021 on 15.07.2021 respectively.

Learned State counsel, however, contends that the petitioner is involved in several other cases. She further contends that he is in custody for

over 1 year and 29 days. She also contends that challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner has not been attributed any injury, he is in custody for about 1 year and 1 month, co-accused have been granted bail, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
