Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 21.02.2021, under Sections 498-A (later on added Sections 406, 506 and 420 of Indian Penal Code) at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

Vide order dated 16.08.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 16.08.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sanjeev Kumar, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 16.08.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
