This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of Criminal Complaint No.NACT/3249/2018 titled as Jitender Kumar Vs. M/s Try Web Technologies Pvt. Ltd. & Ors. (Annexure P-1) and summoning order dated 09.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom as well as order dated 22.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) whereby the petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed Person.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further made a prayer that in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and files an

application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also prayed that the petitioner, in fact, wants to file an application for discharge, therefore, any order passed in the present petition should not come in the way of filing the application for discharge and the petitioner be permitted to raise all the legal points available to him in the said application including the ones which have been raised in the present petition.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move any application in accordance with law. The rejection of the present petition would not come in the way of the petitioner to raise all the legal points available to him in law in the said application/proceedings including the ones which have been taken in the present petition. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and files an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court is requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three days from the date of filing of the said application.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of, in view of the abovesaid order.
