The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

It has been stated that the petitioners are the relatives of one Satish Kumar, against whom an FIR has been registered and the said Satish Kumar is the sole accused in the said FIR. However, the petitioners are also being harassed being the relatives of the said Satish Kumar.

A perusal of the petition would show that no representation has been given by the petitioners to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the matter was of grave urgency and, thus, he has approached the Court without giving a representation to respondent No.2. He, however, prays that the petitioners would withdraw the present writ petition and would submit a detailed representation to respondent No.2 within a period of three days and further makes a request that the said representation may be considered by respondent No.2 and appropriate action on the same may kindly be ordered to be taken.

In view of the above said facts and circumstances, the petitioners are permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a detailed representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondent No.2, who is directed to look into the representation and take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and that this order shall not debar the State from proceeding against the petitioners, if involved in any case.

With the above observations, petition stands disposed of.
