MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for quashing of the impugned order dated 02.08.2021 (P-7), passed by respondent No.2, whereby petitioner was dismissed from the post of Supervisor without conducting any departmental inquiry despite the fact that she had been appointed through regular mode of selection.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy of appeal under the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1970.

Permitted to do so.

In case an appeal is filed within one week from today, the same shall be considered and decided by passing speaking order in accordance with law within next four weeks, positively, and failure thereof, may entail legal consequences.

It is made clear that appellate authority while examining the point of delay, if any, shall take into consideration the factum of present writ petition being pursued by the petitioner against the impugned order under a *bona fide* impression.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as well as subject to the observations made herein above.

Pending civil misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
