Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.4 to regularize the services of petitioner as Computer Operator/Samiti Clerk-cum-Computer Operator.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from his client, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 10.12.2020 (P-6) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, A.A.G., Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the

innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.4, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 10.12.2020 (P-6), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of six months from today.
