This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C., in DDR No.32, dated 08.04.2018 under Sections 307, 148 & 149 of the IPC and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act (Annexure P-1) in case FIR No.57 dated 04.04.2018, under Sections 307, 427, 148 & 149 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-2).

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for 10 months, since 20.06.2020.

[3]. After completion of the investigation, Challan against the petitioner has already been submitted, but the trial is yet to commence. Even the Charges are yet to be framed. As such further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not called for.

[4]. For the aforesaid reasons, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
