Petitioners have filed these separate petitions under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail, pending trial in case FIR No.110 dated 30.05.2017, registered under Sections 22, 25, 27-A, 28, 29 and 30 Act, 1985, at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana. The petitioners are in custody since their arrest on 20.04.2019 and 09.06.2017 respectively.

As per prosecution, on 30.05.2017, a secret information was received by the police and acting upon the same, 7 kgs of heroin was received from the accused persons.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned

counsel for the parties that the prosecution has examined all its witnesses

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and closed the evidence on 20.02.2020.

At this stage, learned counsel for accused-Gulzar Singh submits that on account of poor health, the petitioner deserves the concession of regular bail. He has invited the attention of the Court to the medical report sent by Dr. Jaskaran Singh, Medical Officer, Central Jail, Ludhiana, appended with the short reply by way of affidavit of Rajiv Kumar, Arora, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana as Annexure R-1.

A perusal of the report reveals that the accused Gulzar Singh has shown significant improvement in his health, due to medication and his general condition is stated to be stable.

Resultantly, no ground is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioners.

Both petitions dismissed.
