Petitioner has filed this third petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0021 dated 04.03.2019, under Sections 324, 307, 148 and 149 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the first petition filed by the petitioner for the anticipatory bail was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 20.01.2020 and thereafter, another petition was filed by him which was withdrawn on 21.07.2020. It is also not disputed that the petitioner already stands declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 04.12.2019.

Apparently, this third petition based on the same cause of action is nothing but the misuse of the process of the Court. Resultantly, this third petition for pre-arrest bail is not maintainable.

The petition is dismissed.
