The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent through
trial Court counsel has been received back served.

However, the respondent remains unrepresented.

On 13.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

*This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the
transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu
Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/93/2020 ,titled as
“Vishal Goyal vs. Surbhi Garg” pending in the Court of
Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Dhuri, District
Sangrur, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at
Ludhiana.*

*The petitioner claims that she got married to the
respondent on 17.05.2019. The petitioner claims to be a
lactating mother of an infant boy who is only two months
old. She further claims that presently she is residing with
her parents at Ludhiana and it will be very difficult for
her to travel from Ludhiana to Dhuri, District Sangrur
on each date of hearing.*

*The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the
respondent through his counsel Sh. Ramandeep Singh
Sidhu, at Civil Courts, Dhuri, District Sangrur.*

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts noticed in the order dated 13.08.2021, the application is allowed, the file of case bearing No.HMA/93/2020, titled as “Vishal Goyal Vs. Surbhi Garg”, pending in the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Dhuri, District Sangrur, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The petitioner through her counsel is directed to appear before the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana, on 10.09.2021, who will try the case himself or assign it to the Court of competent jurisdiction.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
