Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a poor person and has taken a loan of Rs.3,38,000/- in the peak covid times. However, he has been subjected to a great hardship on account of misinterpretation of the clauses of the tender document.

Learned senior counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4 submits that the petitioner has a remedy to approach the authorities under clause 42 of the tender document, and in case the petitioner approaches the authorities by filing a representation within a week from today, the same shall be considered sympathetically and decided within 10 days thereafter.

In view of the statement made by learned senior counsel for respondent Nos. 2 to 4, the petition is disposed of in terms thereof.
